

Aviation Services Research Centre, Boeing at Hong Kong Polytechnic University

HAESL's Director & General Manager, Richard Kendall, took part in a signing ceremony on 10 November 2012 at Hong Kong Polytechnic University (HK PolyU) for a Memorandum of Understanding indicating HAESL's participation as a Tier 1 Partner in a new Aviation Services Research Centre to be established at the university. Boeing and the Hong Kong Government are the principal supporters of this venture, and HAESL is joined by sister company Hong Kong Aircraft Engineering Company Limited (HAECO) and China Aircraft Services Limited (CASL) as Tier 1 Partners. The commitment HAESL has made to this new venture is an extension of its existing relationship with HK PolyU's Industrial Centre, with which it has worked collaboratively over many years in designing, developing and producing equipment in support of HAESL's repair and overhaul activities.

In addition to senior representatives from the university and the supporting companies, the signing ceremony was attended by many senior figures from the Hong Kong Government, including the Hon. John Tsang Chun-wah (Financial Secretary) and the Hon. Eddie Ng Hak-kim (Secretary for Education).
